### **Questions for Fruitful Conversations**

- 3. What is your family's or personal vision for life? How does it fit in with the vision of our church? Would other people easily identify the vision that informs your identity? Is there a difference between what we say our vision is and what it truly is?**
- 4. As our society continues to deteriorate what must we be willing to do as individual's, families and a churches? What are necessary requirements for challenging and arresting the secularization of our culture? What are we personally doing toward this end?**
- 5. How much do you pray for this church and for your part in it? Is it a priority? What will the impact be if it is not?**
